Palestine Red Crescent Society: Response Report
As of Saturday, October 7th 2023, 6:00 PM
Until Tuesday, November 7th 2023, 24:00 AM

Palestine Red Crescent Society teams are still responding to the developments on the ground in both Gaza Strip and the West Bank, where the operations are carried out 24/7, For the 32st day in a row.

Latest Updates:

Gaza Strip:

- The intensified Israeli bombardment near Al-Quds hospital from all areas in continuing, which led to the blockage of most of the roads leading to the hospital, which is challenging the operating teams in performing their humanitarian tasks.
- According to official sources, the Israeli occupation forces directly targeted killing 49 journalists, martyred, since the beginning of the aggression.
- As announced by the official sources, the Rafah crossing border is open to evacuate the injuries and people who have dual citizenship (holders of international or foreign passport).

Disaster Risk Management Response:

Gaza Strip: a total of (68,913) families benefitted from the DRM services, with a total of (379,037) individual, the relief items included, food items, hygiene kits, milk, and safe drinking water.

Shipments received for PRCS's services:

A total of (259) shipments were received for PRCS's services and interventions, which is as follow: (food items, medical consumables, supplies and medical equipment, relief items, safe drinking water, milk and diapers for babies, tents, hygiene items) as of November 4th 2023.

Internal displacement:

The IDPs in PRCS's premises in Gaza city and Khan Younis number have reached to (20,000), from which (14,000) are sheltered at the HQ in Gaza city and (6,000) who are sheltered at Khan Yunis.

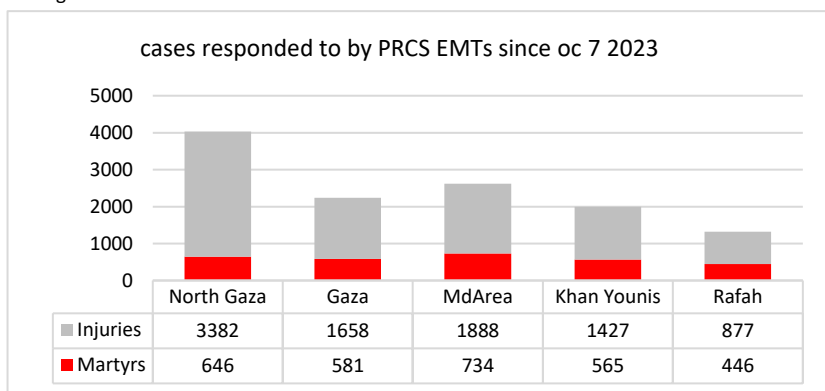

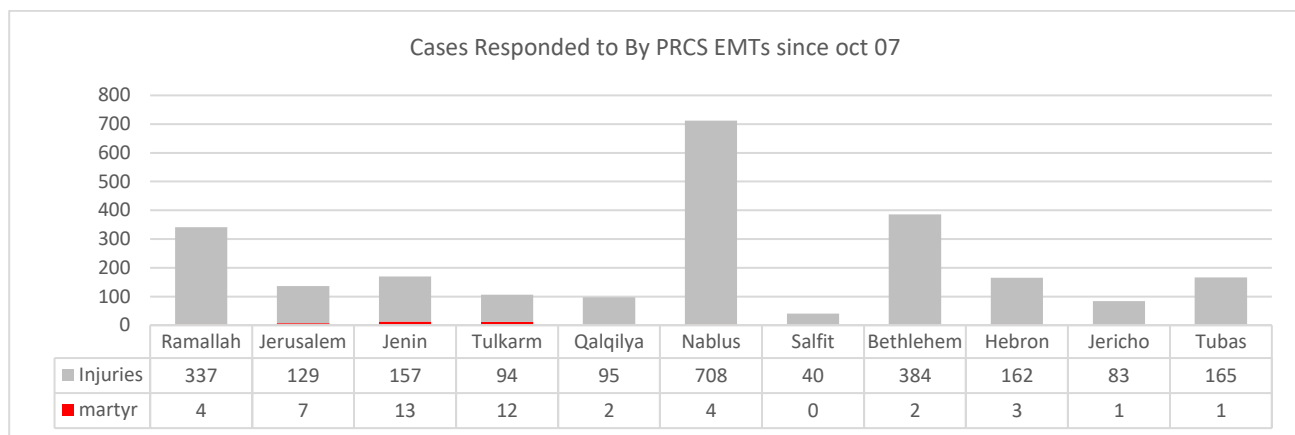
Gaza Strip: PRCS EMTs responded to (9232) casualties, and (2972) martyrs since the beginning of the escalation. The chart below indicates to the figures.

PRCS EMTs responded to (17) casualties as of today November 7th 2023 until 24:00 AM is (20) injury. Thus, the total number of injuries responded to by PRCS teams from Oct 7th 2023 until November 7th 2023 is (2,353) and (49) martyrs.

Community work department interventions:

Gaza Strip: The Community Awareness Committees continued to provide their services to the targeted groups since the beginning of the aggression to date, serving (59306) persons.

During the observation of the care team, a shortage in all resources became apparent, and the breakout of infectious diseases, such as influenza, respiratory infections, some skin diseases, and gastrointestinal illnesses is inevitable.

MHPSS Interventions:

Gaza Strip: The PSS teams continue to provide psychological and psychosocial first-aid to the teams operating during the aggression serving (16,228) beneficiaries.

West Bank: PRCS MHPSS Department provided services to the Gazan workers, who were deported by the occupation forces to the West Bank Governorates. A total of (3327) workers in the shelters benefited from the service. Furthermore, a sponsored post is posted daily on social media, documenting (628,948) views.
