**Palestine Red Crescent Society: Response Report**  
**As of Saturday, October 7<sup>th</sup> 2023, 6:00 PM**  
**Until Thursday, November 16<sup>th</sup> 2023, 24:00 AM**

Palestine Red Crescent Society teams are still responding to the developments on the ground in both Gaza Strip and the West Bank, where the operations are carried out 24/7, For the 40th day in a row.

**The following information in this report is the maximum which our teams were able to collect from direct follow-ups and different sources due to the complete loss of telecommunications and the great difficulty in reaching the sources of information.**

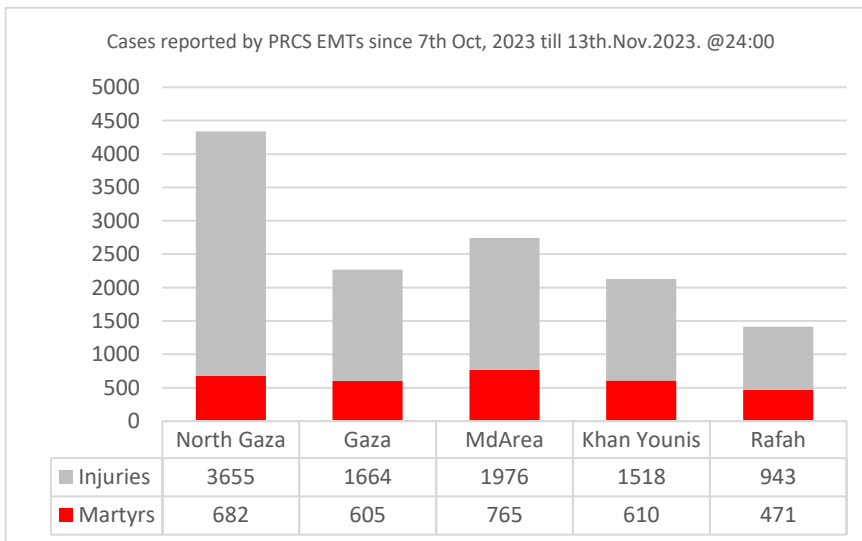
**Latest Updates:**

**Gaza Strip:**

- For the 4<sup>th</sup> day in a row, the telecommunications cut off with the PRCS operations room in Gaza due to the lack of electricity and the fuel runs out from all generators.
- Despite the power outage at PRCS's Al-Amal Hospital, our crews continue to provide medical services there, even if resorting to traditional medicine is necessitated.
- 22 PRCS ambulances vehicles are still operating to respoend in Gaza Strip, and 5 PRCS ambulances are inoperable due to the fuel depletion in Deir Al-Balah.
- Recently, the PRCS ambulances in Gaza strip are facing a difficult challenge to use the very high frequency (VHF) communication because of the cut off electricity and reduction of the recharging wireless devices batteries.

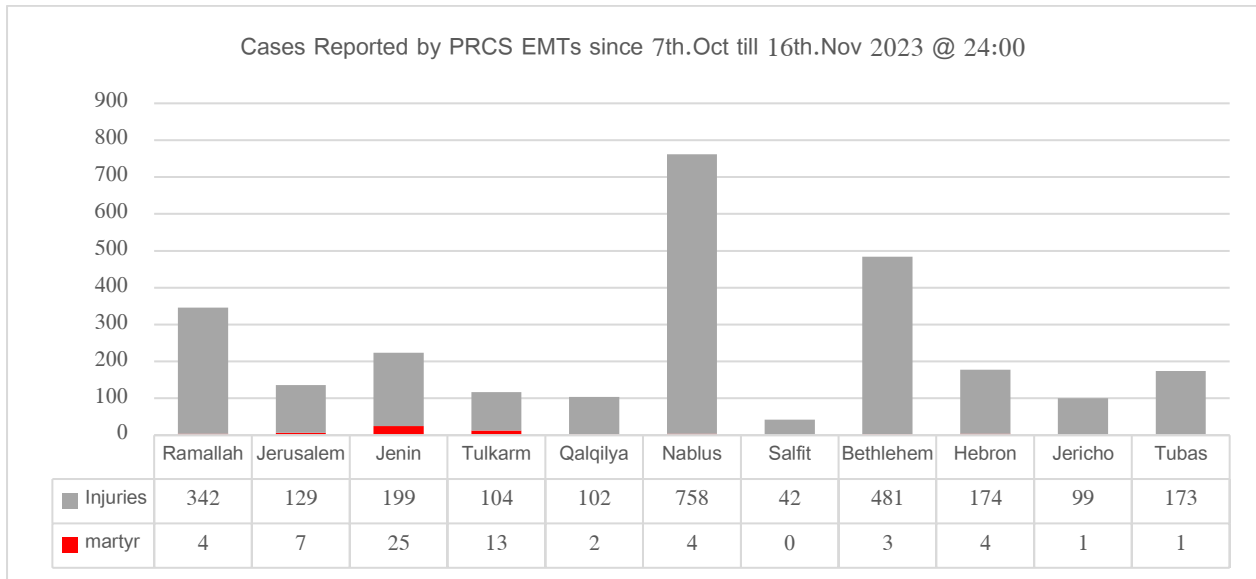
• **PRCS Emergency medical services response**

**Gaza Strip:** PRCS EMTs responded to (9756) casualties, and (3133) martyrs since the beginning of the escalation. The chart below indicates to the figures. As the Ministry of Health announced that (11320) martyrs and (29000) injuries "4650 children - 3145 women - 685 elderly, these statistics remain preliminary due to the many of missing people under the rubble." From 07.10.2023 to 13.11.2023 at 13:00.

**West Bank and Jerusalem:** PRCS EMTs responded to (2) injuries during the Israeli Occupation's raid of Al Far'a camp in Tubas, Nablus and Jenin governorates, as of today November 16<sup>th</sup> 2023 until 24:00 AM. Thus, the total number of casualties responded to by PRCS teams from Oct 7<sup>th</sup> 2023 until November 16<sup>th</sup> 2023 is (2603) casualties and (64) martyrs. And the Ministry of Health reported (197) martyrs and more than (2750) casualties since 7<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 until 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2023.

**Disaster Risk Management Response:**

The information below till the date of 13<sup>th</sup>.Nov.2023 it's not updates due to the cut off communications with PRCS operations room in Khan Yunis and Gaza city.

Gaza Strip: a total of (68,913) families were reached through the DRM services, as (379,037) family members, the relief items included: food parcels and items, hygiene kits, milk for children and safe drinking water.

**Shipments received for PRCS's services:**

The number of shipments reached (544) shipments for PRCS's services, which are as follows: (food parcels, medical supplies, consumables, equipment, non-food items, safe drinking water, milk and diapers for children, tents and cleaning materials) as well as (12) ambulance vehicles until 10.11.2023.
