PRCS Report Update**From Saturday, October 7, 2023, at 06:00 AM****Until Tuesday, October 10, 2023, at 16:00****Gaza:**

- For the third day in row, the PRCS teams continued respond to the field events in the southern governorates, following the declaration of State of Emergency by PRCS
- The central emergency operations room at the headquarters and the Operations Room in Gaza continue to operate 24/7
- **The Israeli Occupation Forces continue to target civilians residential towers and buildings, facilities, mosques, and civilian populations in various areas of the Southern governorates leading to high number of casualties, including a large number of children and women.**
- **Israeli Occupation forces targeted intensely the west part of Gaza city through the so-called (Fire Belt). This leads to destruction of infrastructure causing a big challenge for medical and relief staff due to difficulty in reaching AlShifa' and Al-Quds Hospitals and Central Amubulance Station.**
- **A contact has been conducted with the International Committee of the Red Cross which enhanced the inability to reach some of the injured in targeted area due to infrastructure destruction in the area around AL-Quds hospital and Ambuallnce station serving Gaza.**
- **PRCScommunicated with IFRC and stressed on the inability to reach some casualties in the targeted area as a result of the complete destruction of the infrastructure in the vicinity of Al-Quds Hospital and the ambulance station serving Gaza City, and demanding that a safe humanitarian corridor be provided for medical and relief work teams.**
- The electricity distribution program continues, providing only 4 hours of electricity per day, raising concerns about a humanitarian catastrophe affecting most vital sectors, especially health, water, and the environment, due to the shortage of fuel supplies.
- PRCS EMS/Ambulance centers continue to operate at full capacity in response to the ongoing events. The total number of functioning ambulances in the field is 35, with 5 ambulances on call, with a human capacity of 128 staff and volunteers (incl. paramedics, drivers, and First Responders).
- **According to official sources, the overall statistics for today are (765) fatalities and (4000) injuries as of 13:00, and have not been updated until the moment of this report.**
- **The total cases dealt with by PRCS ambulance teams since the beginning of the events are (1483) cases, including (296) fatalities and (1187) injuries, as bellow:**
- **Al-Quds Hospital received (205) cases, including (204) injuries and (1) fatality(9) , cases as referrals to intensive care.**
- **PRCS Al-Amal Hospital received (83) injuries.**
- **A large number of civilians have been displaced from border areas in various governorates to the center of cities shelters or with host families, due to indiscriminate Israeli shelling in these areas.**
- **UNRWA announced that it received more than 187,000 displaced individuals in its shelter centers. Local resources announced the rising of the number of the displaced people to more than 200,000 in different areas.**
- **PRCS crews dealt with a number of (1,500) citizens who were displaced to Al-Quds Hospital and the HQ in the Tal al-Hawa neighborhood in Gaza, where they were received during the night in the available facilities, and then directed in the morning to nearby shelter centers.**
- Since the beginning of events, a number of (7) violations have been recorded against PRCS crews and headquarter and other PRCS centers, resulting injury of (5) ambulance crews, damage to (6) vehicles, serious damage to the HQ Northn Gaza Strip, and damage to emergency operations room.
- Disaster Risk Management teams began providing urgent field relief to displaced families whose homes were demolished in coordination with service providers from partners. The total number of beneficiary families reached 31 families, details of which are as follows:

- PRCS psychological support team began providing psychological first aid for team members in confirmed incidents, where services reached the number of (186) beneficiaries, to date.
- The community awareness committees have provided their services to affected community groups from the beginning of the events until today, characterized by details bellow:

-The process of emergency operations and the degree of emergency is followed up, and work is carried out according to the emergency plan.

West Bank:

- The number of PRCS EMS/ Ambulances on duty is (39) ambulances, with a human capacity of (78) staff and volunteers (incl. paramedics, drivers, and first responders).
- The total number of cases that PRCS EMS/ Ambulance teams have dealt with in the West Bank since Saturday, October 7, 2023, until Tuesday, October 10, 2023, is (436) at 14:00 and (12) injuries until 16:00. The following table shows further details:

Violations against the PRCS in the West Bank and Jerusalem:

Since the begining of the Israeli military attack on the Gaza Strip and the declaration of a state of war, Palestinian Red Crescent Society crews have faced many challenges and violations in the West Bank, as follows:

The PRCS Disaster Risk Management Department in the West Bank:

- PRCS Disaster Risk Management Department in the West Bank is preparing to provide humanitarian assistance to Gaza workers who have been displaced by Israeli forces from their workplaces in the occupied territories to Tubas governorate where food parcels were provided to 37 persons, in addition to nonfood relief items consisting of 37 mattress and 37 blanket.
- Disaster Risk Management crews in Ramallah Governorate provide relief materials to Gaza workers who were deported by the occupation forces from their places of work in the occupied territories to Ramallah Governorate.
