PRCS Report Update
From Saturday, October 7, 2023, at 06:00 AM
Until Tuesday, October 10, 2023, at 00:00

Gaza:

- For the fourth day in row, the PRCS teams continued respond to the field events in the southern governorates, following the declaration of State of Emergency by PRCS
- The central emergency operations room at the headquarters and the Operations Room in Gaza continue to operate 24/7
- **The Israeli Occupation Forces continue to target civilians residential towers and buildings, facilities, mosques, and civilian populations in various areas of the Southern governorates leading to high number of casualties, including a large number of children and women.**
- The electricity distribution program continues, providing only 4 hours of electricity per day, raising concerns about a humanitarian catastrophe affecting most vital sectors, especially health, water, and the environment, due to the shortage of fuel supplies.
- PRCS EMS/Ambulance centers continue to operate at full capacity in response to the ongoing events. The total number of functioning ambulances in the field is 35, with 5 ambulances on call, with a human capacity of 128 staff and volunteers (incl. paramedics, drivers, and First Responders).
- **According to official report by Palestinian Ministry of Health:**
 1. The occupation's targeting of civilians led to the extermination of 22 families, with a total of 150 martyrs of their members.
 2. The occupation's violations against medical personnel led to the death of 6 health personnel and wounding of 15 others with various injuries.
 3. The occupation's violations led to the death of 8 journalists and wounding of 20 others with various injuries.
 4. The occupation's continued violations against health institutions, 9 of which were targeted, including the Ministry of Health building, Al-Rimal Clinic, Haider Abdel Shafi Medical Center, the destruction of the International Eye Center, and the destruction of more than 15 ambulances,

which resulted deaths in the health system and forced medical teams to work in dangerous and unsafe conditions. It requires the international community to put an end to these violations and protect medical and humanitarian personnel.

5. There are warnings about dangers of the continued Israeli occupation cutting off electricity and water lines and of impact this will have on the wounded and sick, public health and the environment.

6. The Israeli aggression against Gaza and the accumulation of siege crises resulted in a severe shortage of 44% of medicines, 32% of medical consumables, and 60% of laboratory and blood bank supplies, in addition to the collapse of electrical generators and a shortage of fuel supplies.

- As a result of the direct targeting and bombing, Rafah crossing (the only crossing) was closed today in both directions to passenger traffic.

- **The total statistics according to official sources of cases since the beginning of the events are (900) martyrs, including (260) children and (230) women, in addition to more than (4500) injuries “as of 20:00.”**

- **The total number of cases dealt with by PRCS ambulance crews since the beginning of the events was (1834) cases, including (362) martyrs and (1472) injuries.**

- Al-Quds Hospital received (265) cases, including (264) injuries and (1) martyrs, and (9) transferred intensive care cases.

- Al-Amal Hospital received (98) injuries.

- The displacement of a very large number of citizens was reported from the border areas in the governorates to the heart of the cities' shelter centers or with host families, as the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Refugees (UNRWA) announced that its centers received more than 187 thousand displaced people in its shelter centers, while official sources announced The number of displaced people has increased to more than 220,000 in different regions.

- PRCS crews dealt with a number of (1,500) citizens who were displaced to Al-Quds Hospital and PRCS HQ in the Tal al-Hawa neighborhood in Gaza, where they were received during the night in the available facilities, and then directed to nearby shelter centers.

- PRCS's Al-Quds Hospital in Gaza City received a new batch of displaced people, estimated at 200 displaced families who were displaced due to the occupation's threats to target, bringing the total number of displaced people received to 1,700 citizens.

- Since the beginning of the events, a number of (8) violations have been recorded against PRCS crews and headquarters since the beginning of the events, resulting in the injury of (5) ambulance crews, damage to (7) vehicles, serious damage to PRCS headquarter and centers in the northern Gaza Strip, and damage to the Emergency operations room.

- Disaster Risk Management teams began providing urgent field relief to displaced families whose homes were demolished in coordination with partner service providers, details of which are as follows:

- Psychological intervention teams began providing psychological first aid to ambulance teams working in current events, providing the service to (407) beneficiaries, to date (attached report).
- Community awareness committees provided their services to the target groups from the beginning of the events until today, and the details of the interventions were as follows:

- The Emergency Operations Room monitors the status and degree of the emergency, and works according to the emergency plan.

- **West Bank:**

- The number of ambulance vehicles operating in the field is (39) ambulance vehicles and (78) paramedics, drivers and first responders.

- The total number of cases reached (502) that PRCS ambulance crews dealt with in the West Bank from Saturday, 10/7/2023 until Tuesday, 10/10/2023 at 00:00. PRCS crews dealt with during Tuesday, 10/10/ 2023 until 00:00 with (78) injuries, and the following table shows the injuries:

Violations against the association's services in the West Bank:

Since the start of the Israeli military attack on the Gaza Strip and the declaration of a state of war, Palestinian Red Crescent Society crews have faced many challenges and violations in the West Bank, as follows:

Disaster Risk Management Department in the West Bank:

- PRCS's Disaster Risk Management Department provided relief materials to Gaza workers who were deported by the occupation forces from their places of work in the occupied territories to Tubas Governorate, where relief materials were provided to (37) individuals, and the relief materials consisted of: (37) mattresses And (37) is forbidden.
- The Palestinian Red Crescent Society provided relief materials to Gaza workers as a result of the occupation forces deporting them from the occupied Palestinian territories to Ramallah and Al-Bireh Governorate.

- Some workers were accommodated in hotels and the capacity became insufficient, so the rest of the workers were accommodated in the Ramallah Recreation Center, where the number of people present in the center reached (500) individuals and the number is still increasing.
