PRCS Report Update

Date: Oct 26th 2023

From Saturday, October 7, 2023, at 06:00 AM

Until Thursday, October 26th, 2023, at 24:00

According to PRCS's president announcement, PRCS declared a state of emergency at the highest level in both Gaza Strip and the West Bank where the national society operates to fullest humanitarian and resource capacity for the 20th day on the row.

Latest Update:

Gaza Strip:

- The ministry of health announced today a complete collapse of healthcare services in all hospitals in the southern governorates due to the ongoing targeting of all aspects of life in the Gaza Strip.
- Al-Quds hospital/PRCS continues to provide its services to the wounded, injured, and displaced individuals out of its national and humanitarian duty, despite the Israeli occupation's threat to evacuate the hospital and the intense targeting and bombardment of the surrounding area and its main headquarters.
- The fuel for Gaza's sole power plant has run out, along with the closure of the Rafah crossing border, and the suspension of fuel supplies, and the interruption of water. This portends a humanitarian crisis that is affecting the vital sectors, particularly the health, water, and environment sectors.
- The Israeli occupation forces continue their intense airstrikes across the strip, targeting towers, industrial and vital facilities, residential buildings with their inhabitants' mosques, churches, main streets, and civilian population in various southern governorates. This has resulted in a significant number of casualties, mostly among children and women, and intensive infrastructure damage, in addition to civilians being displaced in search of safety.
- The numbers of casualties among healthcare workers has reached 73 martyrs, including doctors, • paramedics, and nurses, up to this moment.
- The officials have received 2000 notification of missing individuals under the rubble, including 940 are children.
- According to the MoH officials in Gaza 57 health centers are out of service as a result to the constant targeting from the occupation forces, in addition to running out of medicine, medical consumables, supplied, medical equipment, fuel and 25 EMS ambulances are out of service.
- Four ambulances belonging to the PRCS went out of service due to severe violations and significant damage.
- The MOH confirmed that the number of casualties in Gaza Strip increased after the Al Mamdani hospital massacre, where the number of martyrs during the past 48 hours reached 900 martyrs, a large number of them in the southern governorates of Gaza to which the occupation asked the population to displace.

West Bank & Jerusalem:

PRCS's emergency teams in all West Bank governorates, including Jerusalem, have dealt with (37) fatalities and (1945) injuries since Saturday, October 7th 2023, up to Thursday, October 26th 2023 at 24:00. The PRCS teams in the West Bank and Jerusalem governorate dealt with (23) injuries on Thursday, October 26, 2023."

Violations against PRCS services:

Gaza Strip: Since the beginning of the Israeli military attack on the Gaza Strip and the declaration of the state of war on October 7th 2023, (19) violations against the teams and PRCS's premises have been recorded. These violations resulted to the martyrdom of (4) paramedics, the injury of (5) paramedics, damage to (10) ambulances, and significant damage to the NS HQ in the northern Gaza Strip, as well as damage to the emergency operations room.

West Bank: Since Saturday, October 7th, 2023, the Palestine Red Crescent Society- PRCS teams have faced numerous challenges and violations, with (70) documented violation incidents.



Occupied Jerusalem: Since Saturday, October 7th, 2023, the Palestine Red Crescent Society- PRCS teams have also encountered several challenges and violations, with (**3**) violation incidents documented.

The displacement of citizens in Gaza Strip:

- Since the beginning of the escalation, PRCS's HQ, Al-Quds hospital, Khan Yunis branch, and Al-Amal hospital have witnessed the displacement of thousands of citizens seeking refuge. This is due to the continued threats by the Israeli occupation forces to target civilian homes. The two HQs are experiencing extreme overcrowding beyond their capacity, with hundreds of displaced individuals sleeping at the entrance of the facilities, administrative offices, and patient rooms. The estimated number of displaced citizens at the PRCS's premises in Gaza and Khan Yunis is over 13000, with 9000 in Gaza HQ, and 4000 in Khan Yunis branch. This increase in the number of displaced individuals is due to the escalating Israeli threats, with the latest displacement of more than 2000 citizens due to ongoing attacks and the destruction of homes in Tel Al-Hawa neighborhood near the hospital. It's worth noting that there is an increase in the number of displaced individuals at by around 1000 compared to daytime.
- A significant number of citizens have been displaced from border area in the governorates to the middle cities, either to shelter centers or with host families. UNRWA announced that its centers have received more than 400,000 displaced individuals. Furthermore, official sources have reported an increase in the number of displaced individuals to over 1.4 million in various areas.
- Israeli targeting has also affected schools, with the occupation taking **19** schools out of service due to severe damage. Furthermore, **160** schools have suffered varying degrees of damage, exacerbating the suffering and overcrowding of the displaced individuals in shelter centers.

Disaster Risk Management Interventions:

Gaza strip:

Today, PRCS received 779 food parcels from the Qatar Red Crescent in Gaza City, which were placed in the PRCS warehouses for distribution to IDPs, and the remaining 1221 food parcels will be received.

PRCS have distributed 1131 hygiene kits to the displaced families at Al-Quds Hospital which supported from the Qatar Red Crescent and CARE.

PRCS have distributed 150 food parcels for the displaced families which have children with cancer patients from humanitarian assistance that entering Gaza Strip through Rafah crossing border.

Due to the threats from Israeli occupying forces to target civilians, the provision of immediate field relief services in the governorates of Gaza and North Gaza was impeded. Relief services were limited to provide assistance to internally displaced persons at PRCS's premises (Al-Nour city and Al-Amal city), the hospitals, and shelter centers.

Disaster Risk Management distributed non-food relief items as follow:

West Bank and Jerusalem:

The disaster risk management provided relief items to Gaza workers who were relocated by occupying forces from their workplaces in the occupied territories to the West Bank governorates, Ramallah and Al-Bireh, Tubas, Qalqiliya, Nablus, Jerusalem and Jenin. Relief items included mattresses, blankets, hygiene kits, kitchen kits, and towels for a total of 405 individuals.

The intervention and response team of the Society at the Bani Na'im branch conducted a rapid assessment of the affected families in the area of Sha'ab al-Batm - Musafir Yatta due to attacks by settlers on their residential tents and the destruction of their properties

Community Awareness Committees Interventions:

Gaza Strip: since the beginning of the escalation, PRCS's teams have been providing support to 58,618 beneficiaries.

Conducted an awareness session for both genders among the displaced individuals at PRCS's branch in Khan Yunis, the session included personal hygiene, water, and sanitation topics. Where 285 people were reached by the session.

Psychological Health Interventions:

Gaza strip: the psychological intervention teams continue to provide initial psychological first aid to the emergency medical teams working in the ongoing events. This service has benefited 7100 individuals.

West Bank: the psychosocial health department provided its services to 'Gaza workers who were relocated by occupying forces to West Bank governorates'. The total number of beneficiaries in shelter centers was 3084. Additionally, daily informational material was funded on social media platforms, with a total of **59,151** which included:

- Dissemination of informative message.
- Provision of initial psychosocial first aid.
- Social and psychological support during times of war and crises. •
- Supply of assistive devices through the rehabilitation department.
- Daily guidance posts on social media platforms. •

Youth and volunteers' contributions:

Gaza Strip: Volunteers have been actively working since the moment the Society declared a state of emergency, responding to work in all the Society's facilities. The operational capacity of the volunteers on this day reached (120) volunteers.
