PRCS Report Update

From Saturday, October 7, 2023, at 06:00 AM

<u>Until SUnday, October 22, 2023, at 14:00</u>

According to PRCS president to declare emergency status and raise the degree of alert and readiness, PRCS is working round the clock with its full humanitarian and physical power since the **Sixteenth day** in a row and is still responding to accelerations on the ground.

Latest Update:

Gaza Strip:

- Alquds hospital is still providing the required medical treatment to the patients, injured and the IDP as per its humanitarian and national obligation though it is still under the threat of evacuation from the occupation forces, and the neighbouring areas are under constant targeting and bombing.
- The occupation forces targeted 24 residential towers in Alzahra's city in the middle governerate of Gaza which escalated the civilians suffering and increased the number of IDP.
- The public authorities has received 1450 missing people under the rubble from which 720 are children.
- 7 hospitals are out of duty due to the occupation's targeting of its infrastructure and neighpouring areas.
- 51 medical personal victims were killed since escalation including doctors, paramedics and nurses.

West Bank

The total number of cases that PRCS EMS/ Ambulance teams have dealt with in the West Bank since Saturday, October 7, 2023 is (1,766), in addition to (35) martyrs until Sunday 22 October 2023, 14:00. While PRCS crews dealt with (15) injuries and (2) martyr during Sunday 22 October 2023, 14:00. The following table shows further injuries details:

Violations against PRCS services:

Gaza Strip: Since the beginning of the escalation Oct 7th 2023, (16) violations was recorded against PRCS crews and headquarters resulting the martyrdom of (4) paramedics, (5) injuries of paramedics, in addition to (8) ambulances which sustained severe damage as also the PRCS headquarter North of Gaza strip.

West Bank: Since Saturday, October 7, 2023, the Palestine Red Crescent Society- PRCS teams have faced many restraines and violations in the West Bank, where (58) violations were reported.

Occupied Jerusalem: (3) violations were recorded.

Internal Displacement of citizens in Gaza Strip:

- Since the beginning of the escalation, the Palestine Red Crescent Society in Gaza City, Al-Quds Hospital and Al-Amal Hospital in Khan Yunis Governorate have witnessed the displacement of thousands of citizens, seeking refuge, due to the continued threats of the Israeli occupation forces to the civilian population by targeting their homes, as the two PRCS/HQ are witnessing a very severe overcrowding situation in excess of their capacity, so that hundreds of displaced people sleeping in front of the entrance to the PRCS, administrative offices and patient rooms. In addition, the number of displaced people in the PRCS in Gaza and KhanYunis its estimated around more than 12,000 citizens distributed at (PRCS/HQ in Gaza: 9,000 citizens and in Khan Yunis: 3,000 citizens), this increase in the number of displaced people due to the increasing of the Israeli occupation forces threats. The latest of the displacement more than 2,000 citizens due to the continuous bombardment and destruction of citizens' homes in Tel Al-Hawa neighborhoods in the vicinity of the hospital. As noticed the number of displaced people increased at night from the daytime around 1,000 IDPs.
- A considerable number of citizens have been displaced from border areas to urban centers and in shelters or with host families, as the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA) announced that its shelters received more than 400,000 displaced people, as official sources announced an increase in the number of displaced people by more than one million displaced people in different areas.
- As occupation targeting of schools has extended, the occupation forced 19 schools out of service due to significant damage, while 160 schools suffered varying degrees of damage, exacerbating the suffering of displaced individuals and their overcrowding in shelter centers.

PRCS Disaster Risk Management Department Interventions:

Gaza strip: As a result of Israeli aggression on Gaza strip and threats to target civilians, it was impossible to provide emergency relief services in the field in Gaza and Northern Gaza governorates. Relief services were limited to providing services to the displaced PRCS headquarters (Al Amal City, and Al Noor), its hospitals, and shelter centers, where the Disaster Risk Management Department distributed non-food relief items, with following details:

West Bank and Jerusalem: PRCS's Disaster Risk Management Department provided relief items for Gaza workers who were deported by the occupation forces from their work places in the occupied territories to the West Bank governorates (Ramallah, Al-Bireh, Tubas, Qalqilya, Nablus, Jerusalem and Jenin), where relief items were provided (mattresses, blankets, hygiene kits, kitchen sets, towels) for (405) individuals.

Psycho- social Department Interventions:

Gaza strip: Psychological intervention teams continue to provide psychological first aid- PFA to ambulance teams working in current events, providing the service to (4,386) beneficiaries.

West Bank: PRCS's Psycho-social and Mental Health Department provided its services to "Gaza workers who were deported by the occupation forces to the West Bank governorates," where their number reached (1,720) beneficiaries in shelter centers. In addition to a daily sponsored guidance publication on social media pages, where the number of beneficiaries reached (59,151) through:

- •Publishing awareness messages
- •Psychological first aid- PFA
- •Psychosocial support in times of war and crises.
- •Providing assistive tools through the Rehabilitation Department
- •Daily guidance posts on social media
