# **Overview of the PRCS Gaza Strip Branches**

**11\7\2024 - 20\7\2024**

## RAFAH GOVERNORATE

- PRCS branch and its facilities are not functional since mid May after the ground military operation.
- EMS teams have been reallocated in two locations: one inside the ICRC field hospital and the second inside the UK field hospital.
- All PRCS medical points (Al Nasr, Al Attar, Park, Tel Al Sultan medical points) in Rafah were closed after the ground military operation in May.
- 3 PRCS IDPs camps are still in Al Mawasi Rafah (North West al Mawasi).
- Aid consignments are halted due to the closure of the Rafah crossing by the occupation.

## Khan Younis Governorate

**The PRCs has restored operations in most of the departments at Al Amal Hospital. The medical teams have started doing surgeries.**

Services provided in the governorate:

- EMS services center (reopened on 19\5\2024)
- 9 IDPs camps.
- 3 Primary health care centers
- 2 Medical points
- 2 Field hospitals
- Relief assistance distribution disrupted due to Rafah closure

## Central Governorate

**Services provided in the governorate:**

- EMS services
- Relief services disrupted due to Rafah closure
- PHC services are provided in Deir Al Balah clinic
- 30 displaced families are housed at the branch.
- 5 IDPs camps: one for people with disabilities and another one for cancer patients.
- 5 Medical points

## GAZA GOVERNORATE

- The PRCS has resumed provision of its medical and humanitarian services in the governorate after being non functional since 14/11/2023.

## NORTH GAZA GOVERNORATE

- The PRCS has reopened its North Gaza Branch & EMS center and its clinic.
- The PRCS opened 2 clinics.

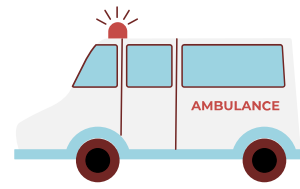
### **The PRCS provides EMS services to Palestinians in Gaza and North Gaza governorates since the 27th of May through:**

- 5 ambulances
- 13 EMTs
- 12 volunteers (First responders).

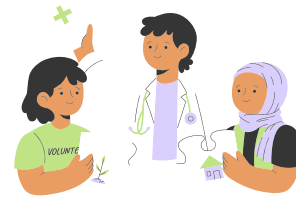
# **Humanitarian Intervention in the Gaza Strip**

**(7/10/2023 - 20/7/2024)**

- Emergency Medical Services (EMS)
- Community health services & health awareness
- Psycho social support
- Rehabilitation services



**22,934** injured persons received first aid services & **7,366** fatalities were evacuated by PRCS teams. In addition, the teams provided emergency medical services to additional 50,148 emergency medical cases.



**345,990** individuals benefiting from community health services & health awareness activities. They organized 117,148 activities benefiting 228,842 individuals.



**96,386** individuals benefiting from psycho social support activities.



**4,150** individuals benefiting from rehabilitation services, 600 received assistive devices.

These services are being offered across the displacement camps established by PRCS, at their medical posts, as well as in shelters managed by UNRWA.

# Medical Posts & Clinics



- **In the Gaza governorate, the PRCS runs 2 medical points (Al Sabra & Al Sahaba) after the closure of Al Shujaiya medical point due to the Israeli occupation forcible evacuation order.**
- **In the North Gaza governorate, the PRCS runs 3 medical points to provide medical services.**
- **In the Central governorate, PRCS runs one clinic and 5 medical points (Al Nuseirat Medical Point, Al Basah Medical Point, Al Zawayda Medical Point, Al Sawarha Medical Point and Bureij Medical Point).**
- **In the Khan Younis governorate, PRCS runs 2 clinics (Al Amal & Al Mawasi) after Ma'an clinic went out of service and 1 medical point (Al Qararah Medical Point) after Bani Suheila Medical Point went out of service.**
- **In the Rafaha governorate, all medical points were all closed after the Israeli ground military operation started in May.**

**As of 20\7\2024, estimated number of beneficiaries is 371,360.**



Humanitarian interventions

The PRCS runs 17 IDPs camps.

- The PRCS IDPs camps are being reallocated in new areas due to heavy bombardment mainly across the Southern Gaza Strip.
- The PRCS has set up one camp for people with disabilities and another one for cancer patients in the Central Governorate.

- Rafah Governorate: 3 IDPs camps shelter **80 families** (440 persons)
- Central Governorate: 5 IDPs camps shelter **191 families** (1123 persons)
- Khan Younis Governorate: 9 IDPs camps shelter **882 families** (4849 persons)

# Relief Items Distribution

The distribution of relief items has been disrupted since 7\5\2024 due to the closure of Rafah crossing which is the primary point for entry of humanitarian aids into the Gaza Strip.

Entry of humanitarian aid to the North of the Gaza Strip is done through the Jordan Corridor in coordination with the Jordanian Red Crescent Society.

Entry of humanitarian aid through Karem Abu Salem crossing is not easy and not enough due to Israeli restrictions, delays at checkpoints, destroyed roads, unexploded ordnance and fuel shortages.

# Relief Items Distribution

Aid Trucks received (11-20\7\2024)

**On 12\7\2024, the PRCS only received** 11 aid trucks of relief items through the UNRWA .

# Relief Items Distribution

7\10\2023 - 20\7\2024

- As of October 2023, up until the current reporting period, the relief assistance has reached an estimated **(331,827) families, consisting of (1,825,049)** individuals, across the Gaza Strip including PRCS IDPs camps & facilities and UNRWA-affiliated shelters.
- Relief assistance includes distribution of food parcels, hygiene kits, blankets, mattresses, water jerry cans, kitchen kits and other necessities

## **Relief Assistance:**

### **Nour Shams refugee camp - Tulkarem Governorate:**

- Following the Israeli forces raids on the refugee camp during the reporting period, the PRCs conducted rapid assessment for 35 affected families comprising of 193 members. The families received relief assistance including hygiene kits, dignity kits, blankets, jerry cans, kitchen kit, mattresses and tarps.

- To respond to the increasing humanitarian needs arising from the Israeli aggression on the Gaza Strip, the PRCS launched its second revised emergency appeal on 12/12/2023.
  - The appeal sought \$ 298,736,550 in funds from partners and supporters within the international Movement of the RCRC, non-movement as well as local & international entities.
  - As of 10/3/2024, contributions from a variety of national societies, international organizations, and the private sector have fulfilled 20% of the requested cash funds.
