Palestine Red Crescent Society: Response Report

As of Saturday, October 7th 2023, 6:00 PM

Until Saturday, November 18th 2023, 24:00 AM

Palestine Red Crescent Society teams are still responding to the developments on the ground in both Gaza Strip and the West Bank, where the operations are carried out 24/7, For the 42nd day in a row.

The following information in this report is the maximum which our crews were able to collect from direct follow-ups and different sources due to the complete loss of telecommunications and the great difficulty in reaching the sources of information. It is worth noting that data was collected when communication was restored last night November 17th, at 22:10.

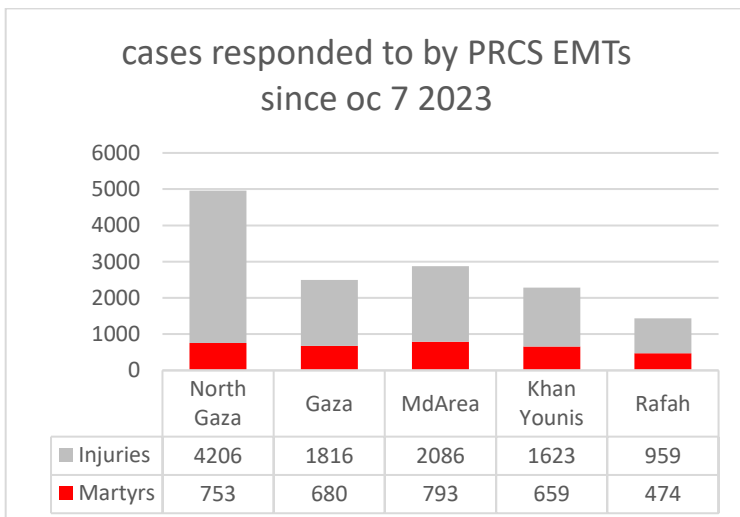
Latest Updates:

Gaza Strip:

- The Central Operations Room in the Gaza Strip remains out of service for the 6th day in a row due to the depletion of electricity sources and fuel from generators.
- Sources of water and electricity have been completely depleted from PRCS facilities, most importantly from Al-Amal Hospital.
- Only 16 out of 22 ambulances are operational due to the depletion of fuel.
- Communication between ambulance vehicles through VHF waves is challenging as wireless batteries cannot be charged in light of the depletion of electricity.
- The PRCS's remaining ambulance crews in Gaza (located in Al-Ahli Baptist Hospital) are no longer operational due to the Israeli Occupation's complete siege of the hospital and the depletion of the crews' supplies for first aid.
- The number of displaced persons in Al-Amal Hospital and the PRCS headquarters in Khan Younis has reached 12,000.

• **PRCS Emergency medical services response**

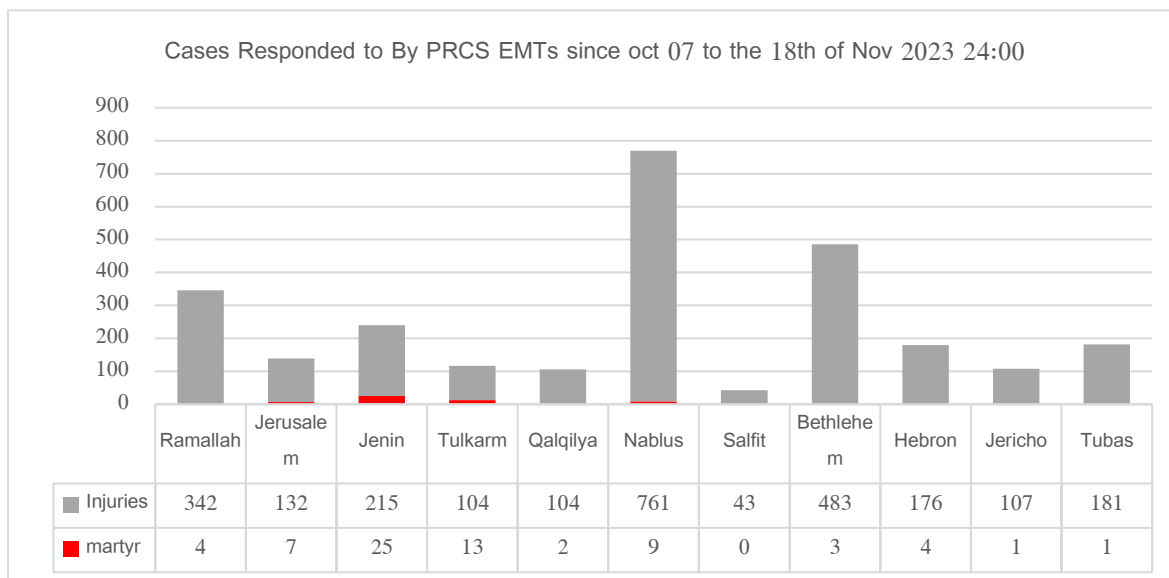
Gaza Strip: PRCS EMTs responded to (10690) casualties, and (3359) martyrs since the beginning of the escalation. The chart below indicates to the figures. As the Ministry of Health announced that (12300) martyrs and (32000) injuries "5000 children - 3145 women - 685 elderly, these statistics remain preliminary due to the many of missing people under the rubble." From 07.10.2023 to 18.11.2023.

West Bank and Jerusalem: PRCS EMTs responded to (5) martyrs and (25) casualties during the Israeli Occupation's airstrike against Balata Refugee Camp in Nablus and Ein Sultan Refugee Camp in Jericho as well at the Occupation's raid of Tubas and target of a school in Esawiyeh village in Jerusalem as of today November 18th 2023 until 13:00 PM. Thus, the total number of casualties responded to by PRCS teams from Oct 7th 2023 until November 18th 2023 24:00 AM is (2648) casualties and (69) martyrs. And the Ministry of Health reported (197) martyrs and more than 2750 casualties since 7th October, 2023 until 16th November, 2023.
