**Palestine Red Crescent Society: Response Report****As of Saturday, October 7<sup>th</sup> 2023, 6:00 PM****Until Wednesday, November 29<sup>th</sup> 2023, 00:00 PM**

Palestine Red Crescent Society teams are still responding to the developments on the ground in both Gaza Strip and the West Bank, where the operations are carried out 24/7, for the 54<sup>th</sup> day in a row.

The following information in this report is the maximum which our crews were able to collect from direct follow-ups and different sources due to the complete loss of telecommunications and the great difficulty in reaching the sources of information.

**Latest Updates:****Gaza Strip:**

- The temporary humanitarian truce enters its sixth day today during which quantities of fuel and gas for cooking enter the Gaza Strip. There is also an increase in the amount of daily trucks entering Gaza carrying humanitarian aid, part of which have entered Northern Gaza.
- The PRCS crews have succeeded in bringing relief aid into Gaza's governorates and northern Gaza. A total of 248 have entered these areas carrying (medicine, medical supplies, foodstuffs, milk, mattresses, and blankets); however, the Israeli Occupation forces are prohibiting fuel trucks from entering these areas.
- Despite prior coordination by the United Nations for the entry of trucks and relief materials into the northern Gaza governorates, the Occupation forces continue to place obstacles in front of relief convoys, as they inspect and interrogate working crews, detain some of them, and subject them to humiliation.
- The fuel crisis in PRCS' Al-Amal Hospital in Khan Younis persists as consumption is reduced to the minimum level, affecting the services provided to the wounded and the sick, including first aid and emergency medical services.
- PRCS colleague Awni Khattab Head of Khan Younis Ambulance Center remains detained by the Israeli Occupation forces for the 8th day in a row. He was arrested during the wounded convoy from Al-Shifa Hospital, traveling through the checkpoint which separates north and south Gaza.
- All hospitals in Gaza are out of service including Al-Shifa and Al-Quds Hospitals due to the Israeli Occupation's siege and ban on medical services. The crews and patients have also been forced into displacement towards the south, increasing the size of the disaster in north of Wadi Gaza, preluding hundreds of victims due to the halt of first aid and medical services to the wounded. The administrations of Al-Shifa and Indonesian hospitals exceptionally resumed work in the dialysis departments only after quantities of fuel entered them, so that kidney patients in the Gaza and North Gaza governorates could benefit from them.
- The Ministry of Health confirms that the occupation forces deliberately target medical personnel and crews, which led to the loss of (207) medical personal lives, (26) from the rescue team members and the wreckage of (56) ambulances that are now un-operable.
- The number of governmental headquarters which the Israeli Occupation has destroyed has reached (103), in addition to (266) schools, (67) of which have gone out of service.
- The number of completely destroyed mosques has reached (88), partially destroyed mosques (174), in addition to (3) targeted churches.
- The competent authorities continue to recover the bodies of the martyrs from the streets and under the rubble, as more than 200 bodies have been recovered from under the rubble or from the streets, awaiting the issuance of an official report from the competent authority. Official authorities have received approximately (7000) reports of missing persons in the rubble and corpses laying in the streets including well over (4700) children and women.


**West Bank:**

- For the 6th day in a row of the humanitarian truce, the PRCS ambulance crews continue to participate in the transportation of released prisoners, suffering from difficult health conditions and wounds due to the Israeli Occupation forces.
- Jenin Governorate: The Israeli Occupation forces have raided Jenin Refugee Camp from Tuesday, November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 20:00pm until Wednesday, November 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 14:30pm in the midst of airstrikes which have targeted a number of houses and vehicles, in addition to the destruction of infrastructure and civilians' properties. Violent confrontations broke out leading to a casualty and the arrest of a number of civilians. The PRCS' crews have transported 1 martyr in as of today Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023 in the afternoon and 1 live ammunition (leg) casualty. While the crews transported the casualty, the Israeli Occupation forces arrested the casualty from inside the ambulance vehicle in front of Jenin Public Hospital on Tuesday, November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 21:30pm.
- Jericho Governorate: The Society's field crews dealt with (10) injuries, including (8) gas suffocation injuries, and (2) beating injuries, during the Occupation forces' raid of Aqabat Jabr camp and Ain al-Sultan camp at dawn on Wednesday, 11/29/2023.
- Ramallah Governorate: The Society's crews transported (3) injuries, including: (2) live bullets, (1) a rubber-coated metal bullet injury, during the Occupation forces' raid of the city of Beitunia in the area adjacent to Ofer Prison, on Tuesday, 11/28/2023,

between 00:00 and 01:30 after midnight.

• **PRCS Emergency medical services response**


**Gaza Strip:** PRCS EMTs responded to (11476) casualties, and (3528) martyrs since the beginning of the escalation, according to the last report from the Central Operations Room on November 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 19:00. The chart below indicates to the figures. As the Ministry of Health announced that (+15,000) martyrs and (+36,000) injuries "6150+ children – 4000+ women and 700+ elderly, these statistics remain preliminary due to the many of missing people under the rubble."

Ambulance centers continue to operate at high capacity in light of the events taking place. Today's operational capacity was (17) ambulance vehicles operating in the field, (2) of which were special use vehicles. The number of staff working within this capacity is (55) including ambulance crews, drivers, emergency response, administration, and volunteers.

**West Bank and Jerusalem:** PRCS EMTs responded to (1) martyr and (14) casualties as of today, November 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Thus, the total number of casualties responded to by PRCS teams from Oct 7<sup>th</sup> 2023 until November 29<sup>th</sup> 2023 19:00 PM is (2976) casualties and (80) martyrs. And the Ministry of Health reported (239) martyrs and more than (3000+) casualties since 7<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 until 28<sup>th</sup> November, 2023.



**Violations against PRCS teams:**

The Palestine Red Crescent Society enjoys special protections yielded by international humanitarian law, particularly the Geneva Conventions, and operates within the framework of its humanitarian responsibilities governed by said legal documents. The following recorded violations against our crews, vehicles, and patients are documented in accordance with the First and Fourth Geneva Conventions, the Additional Protocol (I) to the Geneva Conventions, and customary international law.

### Disaster Risk Management Response:

#### The Gaza Strip:

The PRCS' relief teams continue their various efforts in responding to the displaced in all areas of the Gaza Strip, which are suffering from a major disaster due to the aggression on Gaza, in addition to the displacement centers in coordination with the relevant institutions—the details on this will be provided later on.

#### West Bank:

The emergency assessment team conducted a rapid assessment of the emergency needs of an affected family of 6 individuals in the Ramallah Governorate - Shuqba village, as a result of the Occupation forces demolishing their residential home under the pretext of not having a license. Coordination was made with the International Committee of the Red Cross to cover the cash need.

### Shipments received for PRCS's services:

- The number of trucks that have entered through Rafah Land Crossing has reached (1626) including (1169.5) for the PRCS, which are as follows: (food parcels and items, medical supplies, consumables and equipment, non-food items, safe drinking water, milk and diapers for children, tents and cleaning materials) as well as (16) ambulance vehicles until 24.11.2023.
- (233) trucks were sent to the north of the Strip on November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
