# Gaza

# The situation in the PRCs's branches in Gaza.

- The teams participated in the medical evacuation of dozens of sick and wounded in need of specialized treatment abroad, in coordination with the World Health Organization and other international organizations.
- Two ambulances were stationed inside the Rafah crossing to facilitate the medical evacuation to the Egyptian side.
- The teams participated in retrieving the martyrs' bodies from the streets and destroyed homes, in coordination with various specialized authorities.
- The EMS centers in the Rafah and North Gaza governorates were reopened after being forcibly shut down.
- The teams continued cleaning and repairing the Al Quds Hospital in Gaza governorate in preparation for its reopening after being out of service since 14/11/2023.

## Emergency Medical Services

- The teams evacuated (316) martyrs. They also transferred around (22) decomposed bodies.
- They provided first aid services to approximately (4,805) cases, including injuries from shelling and emergency medical conditions.
- The teams conducted (2) first aid training courses for about (51) individuals, including (29) females. One course was held at the PRCS's branch in Khan Younis for a group of volunteers. The second course was held in cooperation with the ICRC targeting (18) of PRCS medics.
- The teams assisted in the medical evacuation of (411) patients and injured through Rafah crossing point in coordination with the WHO.



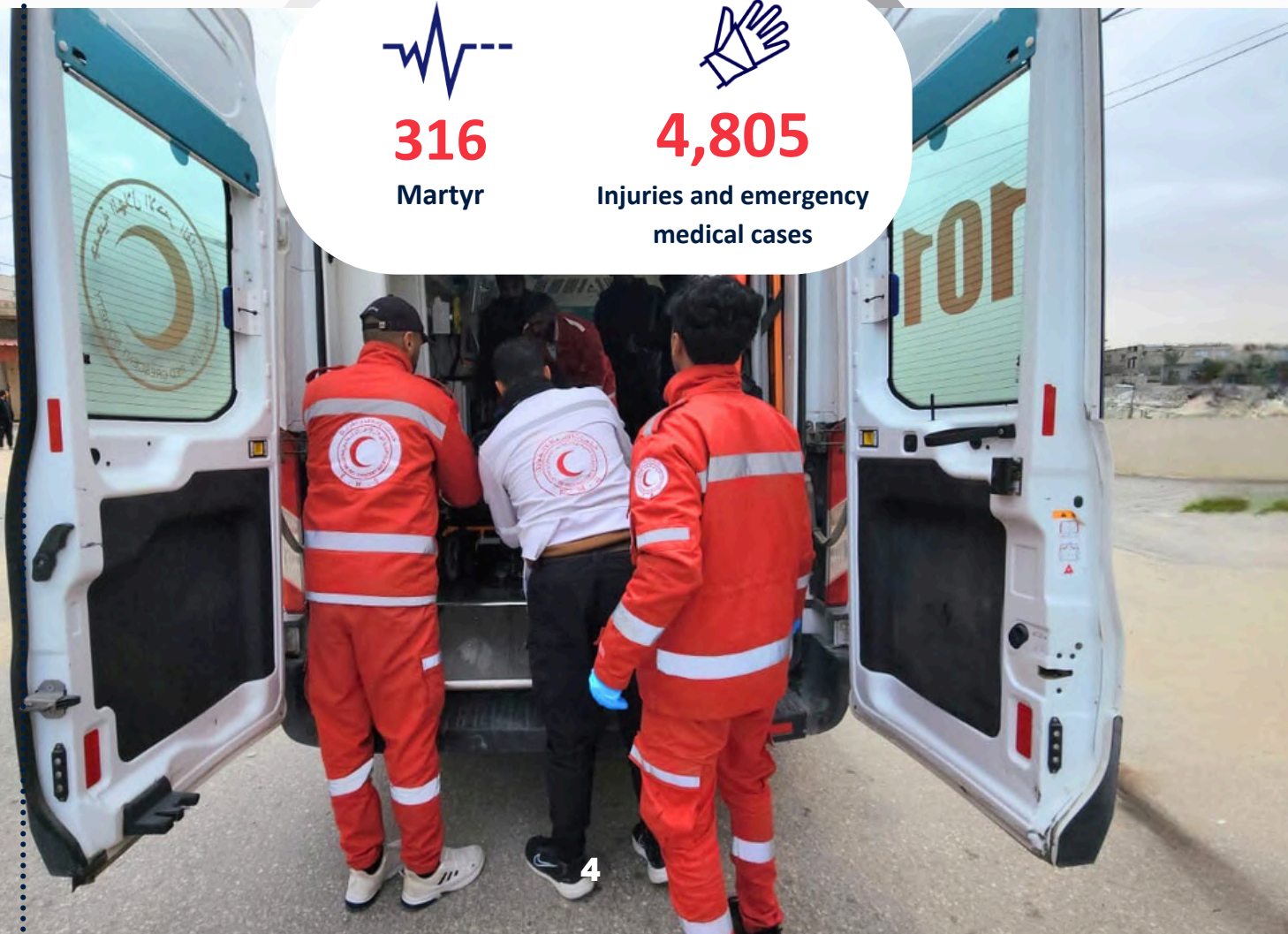

26,076 awareness campaigns on unexploded objects



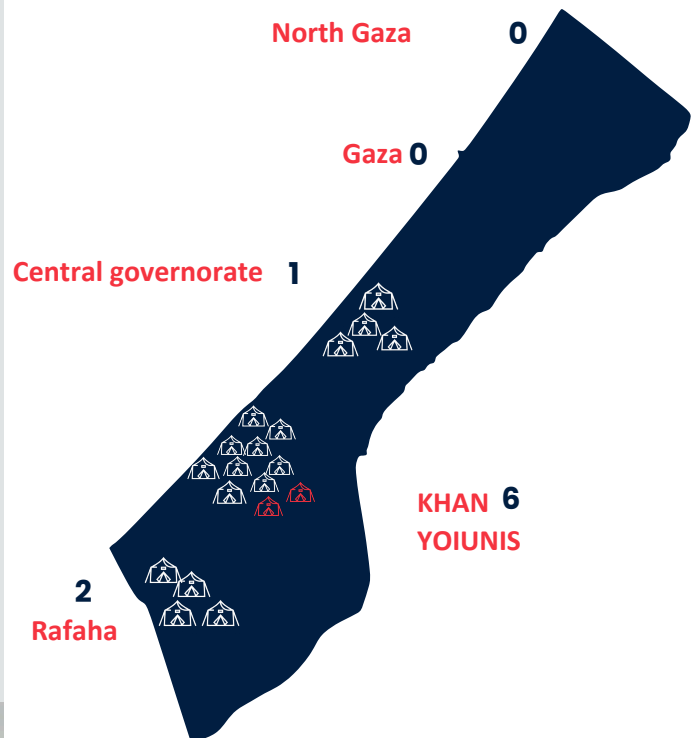
## Shelters

The PRCS distributed (1,772) relief aid trucks to the affected communities through local partners, mainly the Ministry of Social Development.

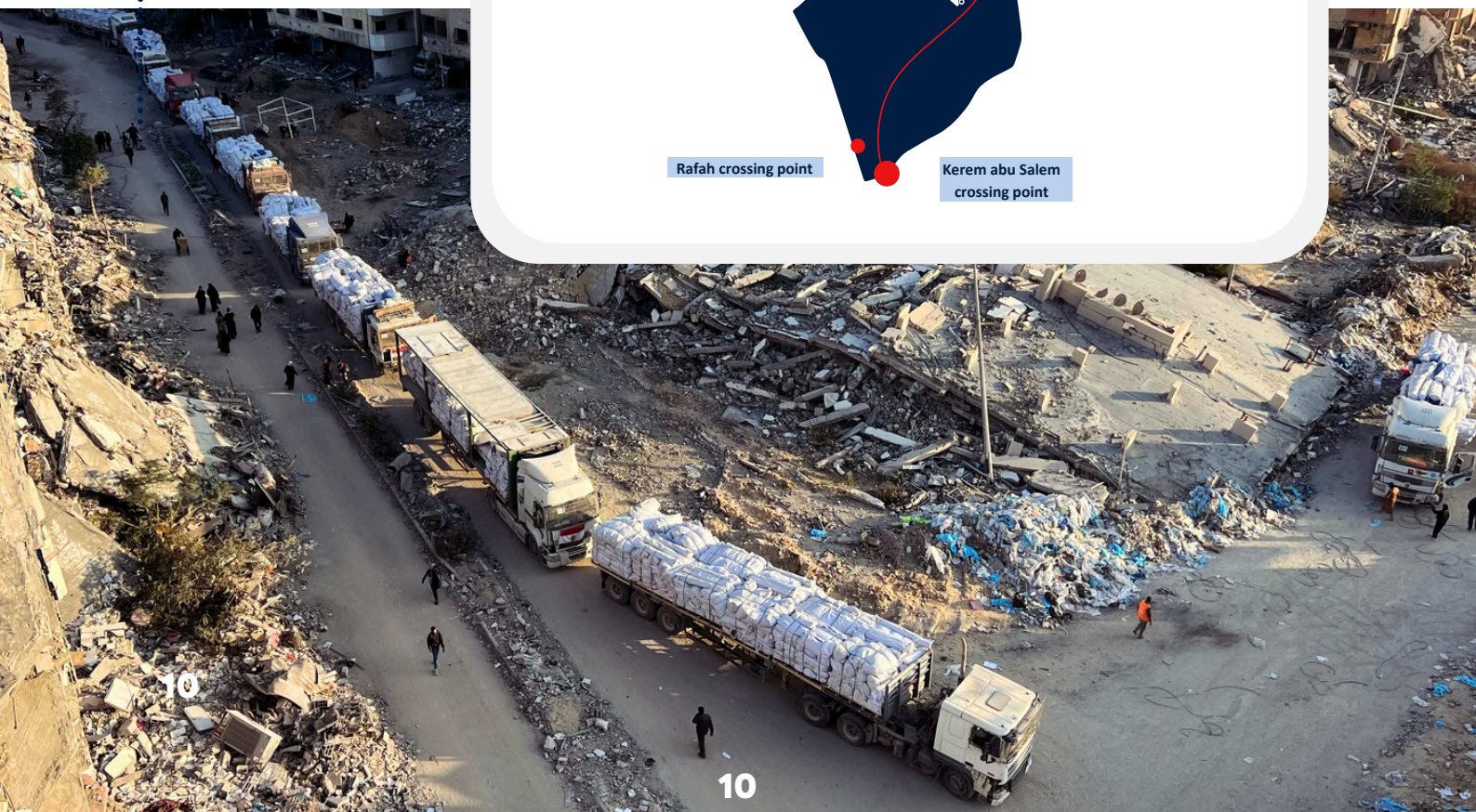

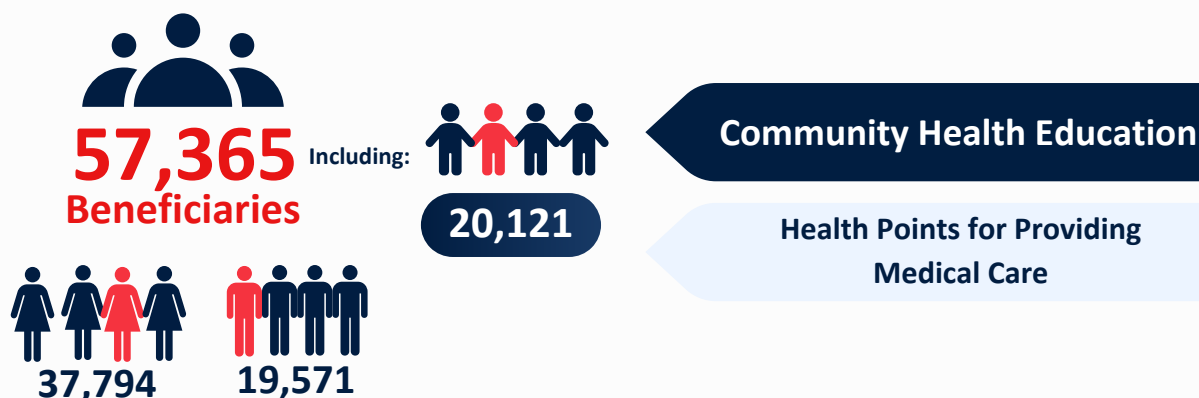

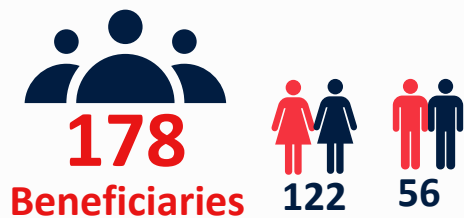


## Emergency Medical Services

Providing ambulance and emergency services across all governorates of the West Bank, including occupied Jerusalem.

During the reporting period, the association activated an ambulance point in the town of Tammun to respond during the military operation there. They provided assistance to (154) injured.

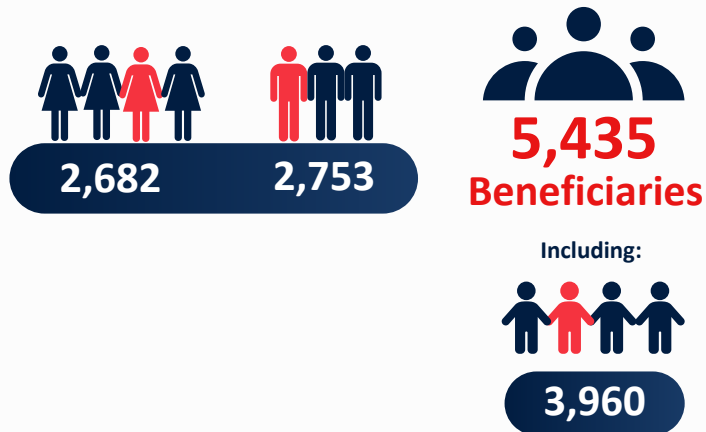






## Psychosocial Support

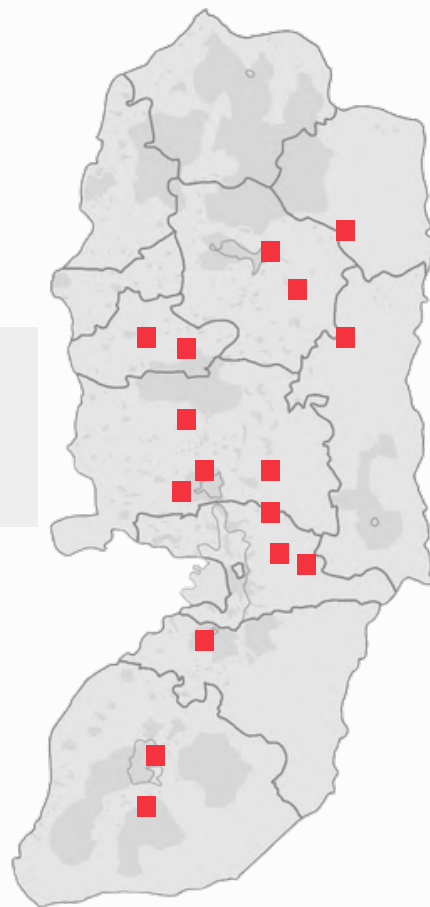

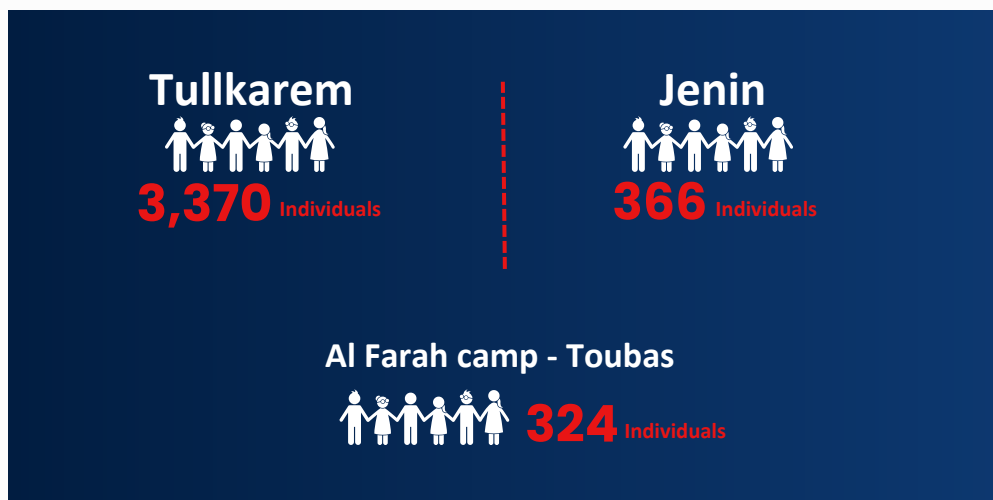
