Emergency Medical Services

- The teams evacuated (590) martyrs.
- They provided first aid services to approximately (7,935) cases, including injuries from shelling and emergency medical conditions.
- The teams assisted in the medical evacuation of (12) patients and injured in addition to (12) companions for specialized treatment abroad.

Hospitals:

Providing secondary and tertiary emergency care services to affected communities.

- PRCS medical facilities have begun receiving dozens of fatalities and injured persons who were waiting for aids in or near “distribution points”.

► Al-Amal Hospital (Khan Younis governorate):

- The hospital has become lacted within an evacuation zone, making acces extremely difficult.

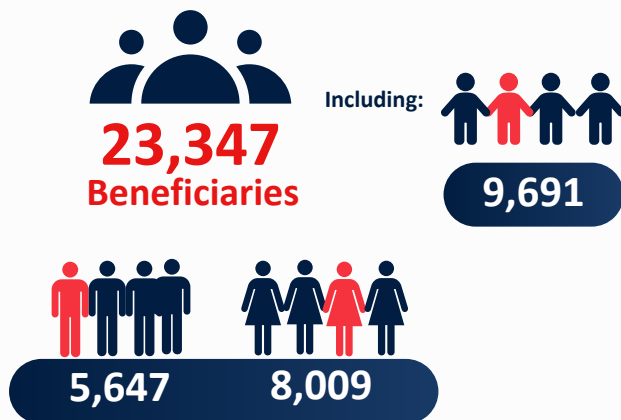

Psychosocial Support

PRCS teams provide psychosocial support services and psychological first aid to affected individuals in hospitals, PRCS IDPs centers and other centers distributed across the Gaza Strip. These services also target the PRCS staff and volunteers.

in cooperation with the Turkish RC Kitchen



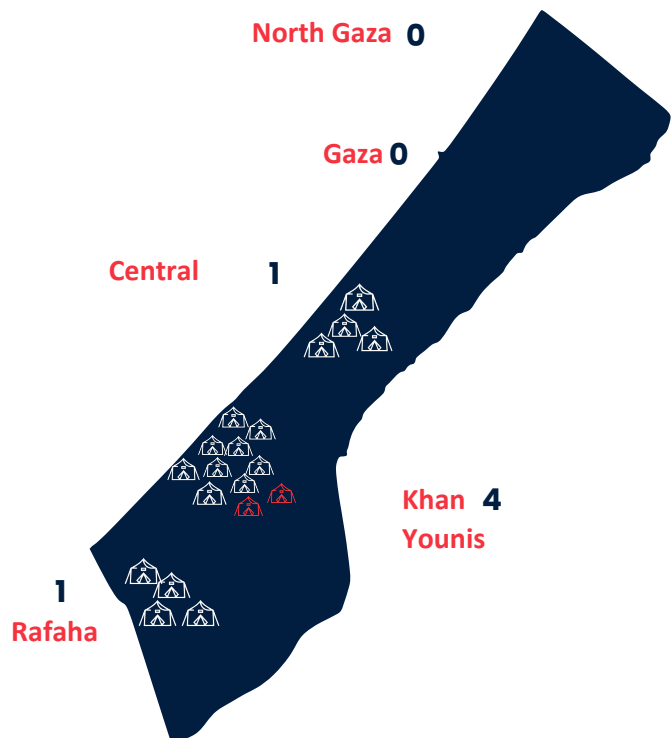
Shelters

These centers accommodate approximately (2,202) individuals.

PRCS teams provide the following services to families residing in these shelter centers:

- Health and medical services, as well as psychosocial support
- Food and relief assistance
- Sanitation and water services
- Lighting and energy services

Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene

Affected communities are provided with safe drinking water, access to save and inclusive sanitation facilities and hygiene supplies

- In cooperation with the German Red Cross, PRCS teams distributed approximately one million liters of drinkable water to displaced persons in the Gaza and the Central Governorates.
- The actual daily production of the four water treatment plants in Gaza and Khan Younis reached approximately 66,000 liters of treated water. These plants are unable to function at full capacity due to various logistical and operational constraints. (The full capacity production of the 4 is 160,000 liters)

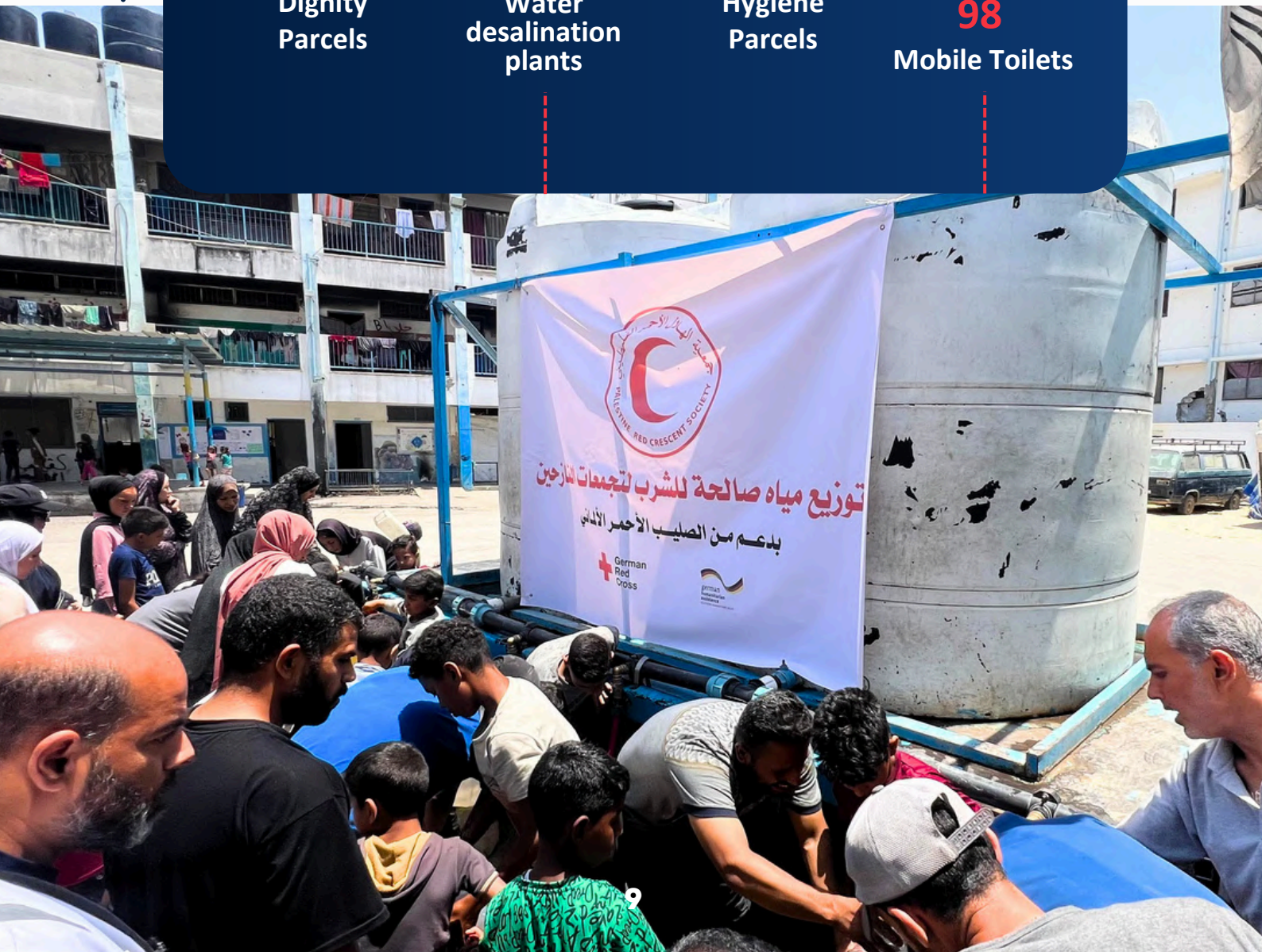

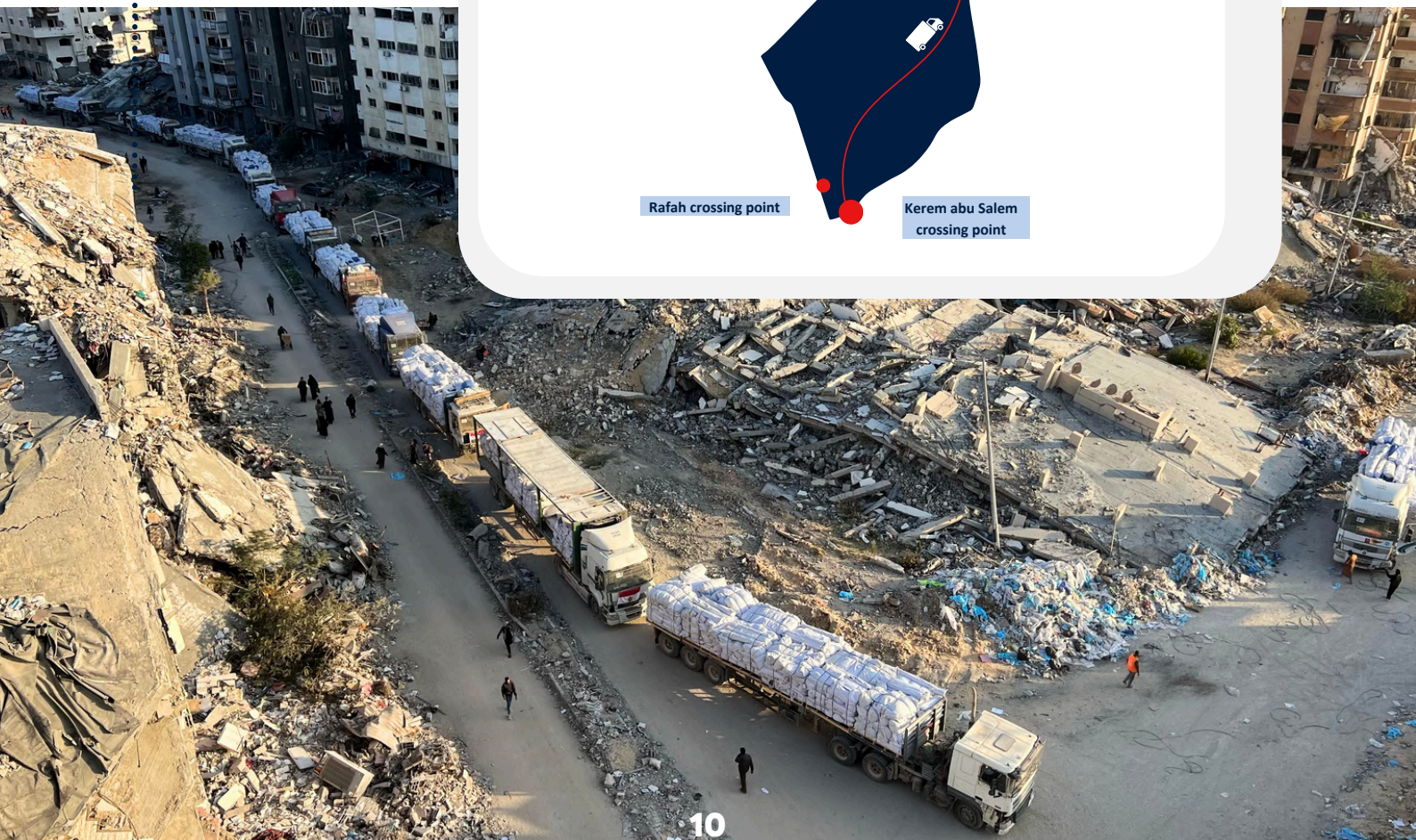
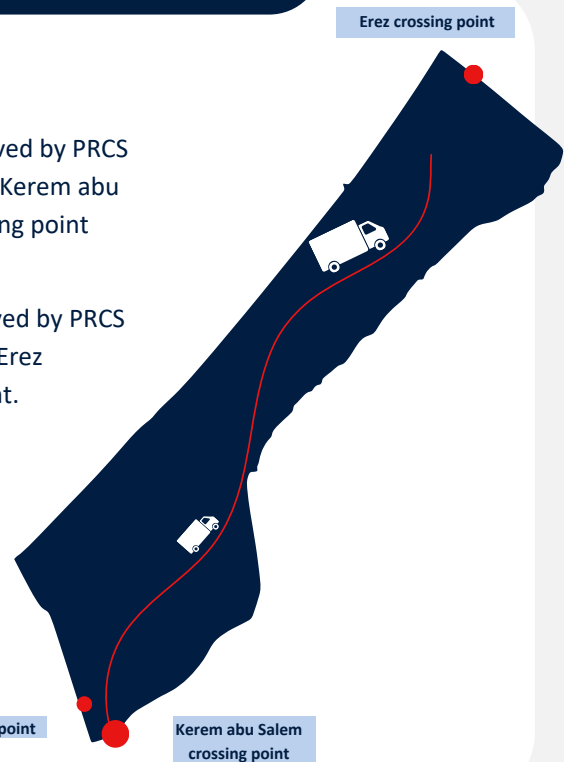


Relief Aid Trucks

- PRCS has not received any relief aid trucks during the reporting period.
- Not receiving any aid trucks since March 2025 has severely impacted PRCS's response operations, due to acute shortage of medical supplies and fuel, and the depletion of food and relief stock.

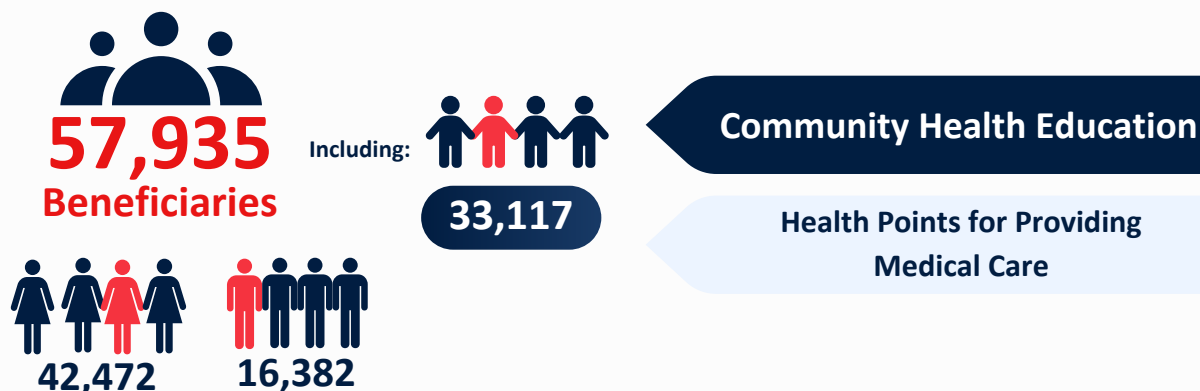
Aid Trucks

Five mobile teams provide the same services across Gaza's five governorates.

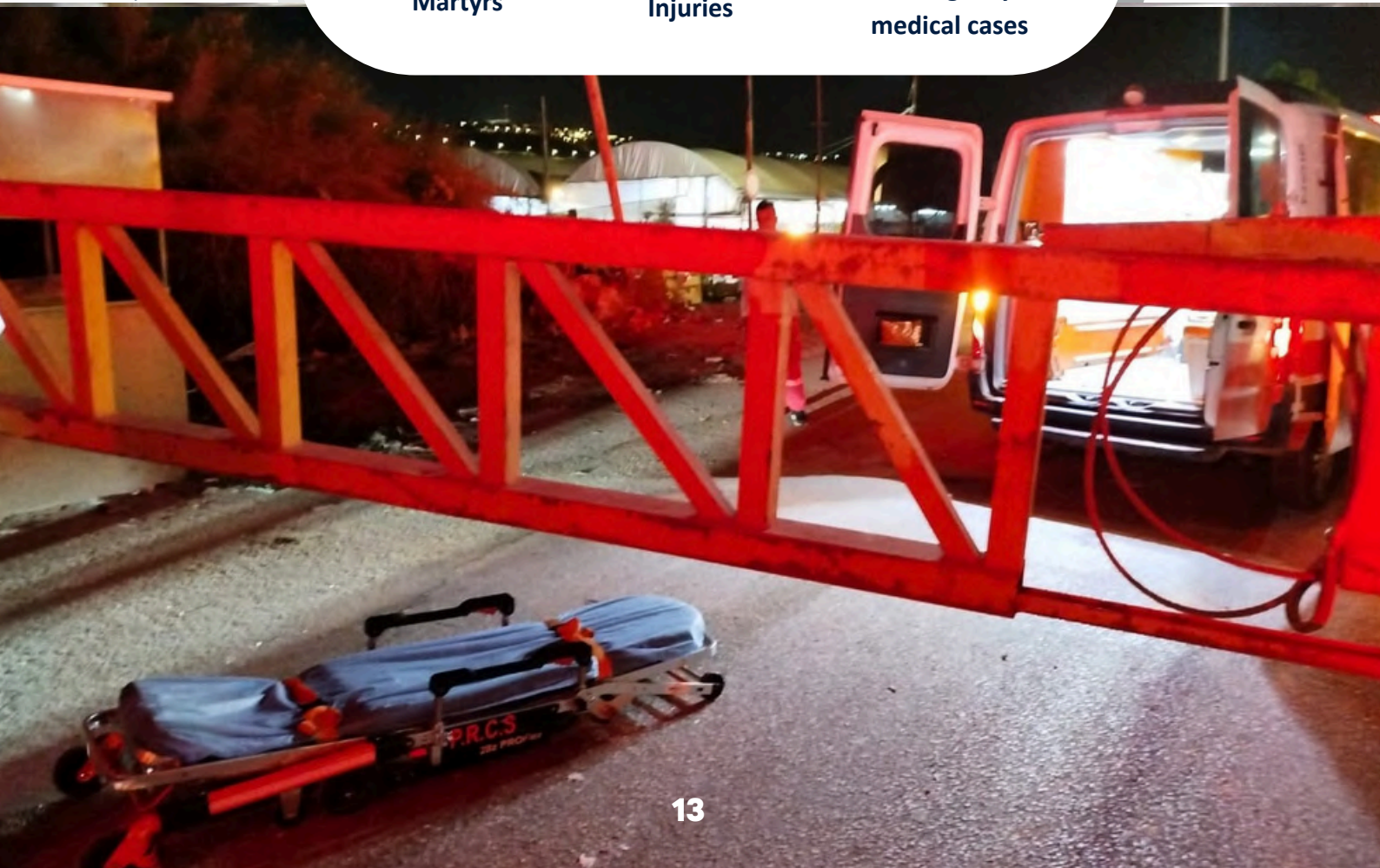

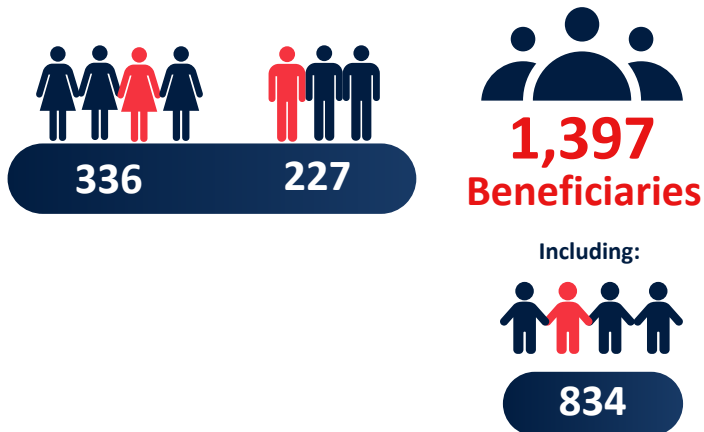

- To support economically affected families in the West Bank, PRCS, in cooperation with the Turkish Red Crescent, distributed food parcels across various areas in the West Bank.

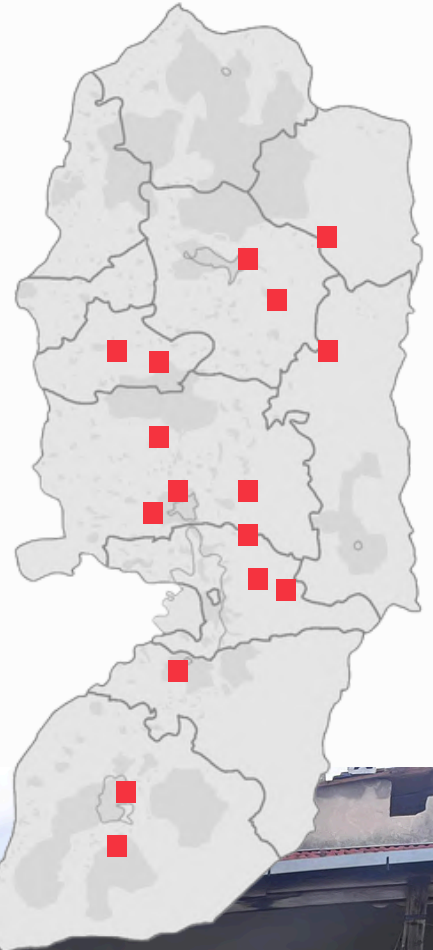
